ROUTE 1

Coastal Route from Huerres to La Isla – “The Mysteries of the Sea Route”

Estimated time: 1:30 h

Difficulty: Easy

Km: 5.43 km (3.37 mi) | Elevation gain: 81 m (266 ft)

A scenic route along rural paths and cliffs, offering views of the Cantabrian Sea, the Sierra del Suevo mountains, and the surrounding area of Lastres. It stands out for its natural and geological landscape.

ROUTE 2

Route connecting Lastres with the Luces Lighthouse, passing by the hotel

Estimated time: 2:45 h

Difficulty: Easy

Km: 9.19 km (5.71 mi) | Elevation gain: 144 m (472 ft)

A pleasant walk connecting the fishing village of Lastres with the Lastres Lighthouse, passing by the San Roque chapel, rural paths, and the meadows of Luces. It offers magnificent views of the Cantabrian coast and its cliffs.

ROUTE 3

Route from La Griega Beach (San Telmo) to La Isla Beach (round trip)

Estimated time: 3:15 h

Difficulty: Moderate

Km: 11.55 km (7.18 mi) | Elevation gain: 321 m (1,053 ft)

A coastal walk between two of Colunga's most iconic beaches, featuring sections along the sea, coves, cliffs, and panoramic views of the Asturian coastline.

ROUTE 4

Picu Pienzu from the Fitu Viewpoint

Estimated time: 4 h

Difficulty: Moderate

Km: 12.17 km (7.56 mi) | Elevation gain: 644 m (2,113 ft)

A climb to one of Asturias' most emblematic peaks through the Sierra del Suevo. The route features mountain landscapes, traditional shepherds' huts, and a summit with spectacular views over the Cantabrian coast and the Picos de Europa.

ROUTE 5

Alto de la Llama – Mayá de Espineros – Maladín and Fontanielles Peaks (Sierra del Suevo)

Estimated time: 3:30 h

Difficulty: Moderate

Km: 12.32 km (7.66 mi) | Elevation gain: 707 m (2,320 ft)

A route through the Sierra del Suevo, passing traditional mountain settlements, highland pastures, and the habitat of the Asturian horse (asturcón). It offers wide views over the Asturian coast and inland valleys.
